- Federal grants frequently require a great deal of effort with a perceived low funding rate

- Most universities have a grants office that provides reports on funding opportunities based on key word searches
- Encourage and support Extension professionals, esp. those working in the field, to serve on grant panels
- Develop personal relationships with NPLs who manage grant portfolios
